RESULT OF THE DRAW - COMPOSITION OF THE GROUPS

The draw of the groups took place on 7th January 2016 in the City Hall of Rouen in the presence of former minister of sports, Valérie Fourneyron, ISF President Laurent Petrynka and UNSS board members, ISF TC president Handball Tom Christensen, and Hrvoje Custonja, ISF delegate/EC Member.

1. PROGRAMME

2. INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP EVENING

Delegations are required to take part in the “International Friendship Evening” organised with the aim of encouraging exchanges between the different cultures of participating countries. The young people are invited to introduce and to promote their countries and their culture in an original way. Each delegation is to organise a stand at the “Tourist Fair” on the theme ‘Suppose you came to spend your holidays in my country’.

This presentation may be made in the form of leaflets, video, CD, photos or other original ideas, for example by offering a taste of typical culinary specialties (dishes, drinks, ...).

In addition each delegation may, if it wishes, introduce a facet of its country’s culture on stage (the stage is yours – dance, songs, sketches ...) maximum 3 minutes.

3. FINANCES AND INSURANCE

3.1. In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the World Schools Championship amount to 50 EUR per person and per night for a maximum of 19 persons (with one team entered) or 37 persons (with 2 teams entered).

3.2. The participating countries must bear the costs of the stay of the referees who will be appointed by the EHF and of the EHF supervisors, the fee amounts to 550 EUR per team (as less than 40 teams will participate).
The travelling expenses of the referees are covered by the National Handball Federations concerned.

3.3. An additional ISF levy of 40 EUR per delegation member will be collected at the time of registration.

3.4. The total sum per person is therefore 400 EUR + 40 EUR = 440 EUR.
For the additional persons, see bulletin 1 - paragraph 5.6.

3.5. The balance of the sum due can be paid in EUR into the **organisers’ bank account at the latest by 1st March 2016.**

All bank charges are the responsibility of the delegations!

OR

The balance of the sum shall be paid in cash in EUR by the Head of Delegation on arrival. Payment by bank cards and /or credit cards will not be accepted.

4. COMPETITION FORMAT BOYS AND GIRLS

Preliminary round 4 groups of 4/5/6 teams – 3/4/5 matches (all x all)

Qualification round 1 - ¼ Finals crossing the groups A and B & C and D

Teams classified 5 and 6 in the groups play all in 1 group.

Qualification round 2 - ½ Finals crossing group AB and CD

Classification round Finals - classification 1 to 18 (boys)/21 (girls)

From the 2nd round matches ending in a tie will be finished by a “Shoot Out” system – light version.

The brand of official match ball (n° 2 for girls and n° 3 for boys) is ADIDAS.

The OC will provide the match balls. Balls for training and warming up however must be brought by the teams themselves.

The OC will provide white glue for all players for all matches. For teams bringing their own glue, only white glue is allowed !

5. CONTROL COMMISSION

5.1. In accordance with General Competition Rules the Organising Committee will designate a Control Commission composed of:

- Members of the ISF Technical Commission Handball,
- Representatives of the OC.

5.2. At accreditation, the Head of Delegation must settle with the organisers the balance to be paid including any bank charges and will present the following documents to the Control Commission :

- proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges,
- the passport of every student bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth,
- a letter from the school confirming that all students of the school teams are full time students at the school, since the beginning of the school year.

When checking is complete, each participant will receive an accreditation card which allows him/her access to the competition, activities and meals.

6. DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION

6.1. In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the Disciplinary Commission will be composed of:

- Hrvoje Custonja, ISF Delegate
- Tom Christensen, President of the ISF Technical Commission Handball
- François Daliphard, President of the Organising Committee



6.2. The Disciplinary Commission will deal with all matters relating to discipline arising during the championship matches and also during the period of the championship where the matters are not covered by technical regulations.

6.3. The Disciplinary Commission's decisions are final. They are passed on to the Executive Committee. It should be noted that where there is a sufficiently serious lack of respect for ISF rules the Disciplinary Commission could disqualify participants, teams or delegations from the competition and to require them to return home before the end of the event.

7. APPEAL JURY

7.1 In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the Appeal Jury will be composed of:

- Tom Christensen, President of the ISF Technical Commission Handball
- Frantisek Taborsky, ISF/EHF/IHF representative
- a Handball expert of the Organising Committee

7.2 The Appeal Jury will decide on all appeals concerning the results of the competition in the light of the rules of IHF/EHF and the rules of the ISF Technical Commission of Handball.

7.3 The Appeal Jury will not pronounce on disciplinary matters.

7.4 Appeal Jury decisions are final and may not be appealed.

8. APPEALS

8.1. Appeals against results or any other appeal not concerning disciplinary matters will be heard by the Appeal Jury.

8.2. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the incident and be in writing in English, French or German.

8.3. The sum of 100 EUR must accompany the appeal. This sum will be refunded only if the appeal is upheld or at the discretion of the Appeal Jury.

9. OBLIGATIONS UNDERTAKEN BY DELEGATIONS

9.1. Each participant is required to be present throughout the duration of the event.

9.2. Each participant is obliged to take part in all of the non-sport activities.

9.3. Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.

9.4. Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.



9.5. The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving-, and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the disqualification of that team.

10. ISF SCHOOL SPORT FOUNDATION

10.1. The ISF Executive Committee at its last meeting in Rome, Italy on 28th October 2014 approved the creation of the ISF School Sport Foundation intended to provide underprivileged school children opportunities to access sports training by highly qualified PE teachers and trainers and to dispose of good quality school sport equipment and infrastructure.

Fundraising for the Foundation will be set up at different occasions. For this we call on your solidarity.

One of the occasions is a Charity Gala Dinner that will be organised during the ISF World Schools Championship and will replace the traditional dinner of the Heads of Delegation. Heads of Delegation will be invited to participate in the Charity Gala Dinner and will be asked to pay an extra contribution of 50 € for taking part. The Organising Committee will then pay the collected money in the Foundation's account.

A second way to raise funds for the School Sport Foundation is a free contribution that you can add to the 40 € ISF levy of the participants in the World Schools Championships. You can add 5 €, 10 € or 15 € per participant to the ISF levy to pay. Instead of paying 40 €, you thus pay 45 €, 50 € or 55 € per participant. The Organising Committee will pay the surplus in the ISF School Sport Foundation's account.

In this way everybody will contribute to this good cause. We thank you in advance for your appreciated cooperation.
